Dr. Morris Freedman is Head of Neurology and Medical Director of Cognition and Behaviour at Baycrest Health Sciences. He is a Professor, Division of Neurology, Department of Medicine, University of Toronto, and a scientist at the Rotman Research Institute of Baycrest Centre.

Dr. Freedman is carrying out research aimed at improving our understanding of the cognitive mechanisms underlying dementia due to Alzheimer's disease and frontotemporal dementia. His research also includes the development of cognitive assessment procedures in dementia, such as the Toronto Cognitive Assessment which was recently published in Alzheimer's Research & Therapy and the Object Alternation Test. In addition, he has special expertise in distance learning at a global level using videoconferencing, an area in which he has taken a major leadership role.
