PRESENTATION TITLE:

Ethical Considerations Related to Sexual Expression and Older Adults

PRESENTERS:

Andria Bianchi, PhD, is a Clinical Ethicist at the Centre for Clinical Ethics (CCE) – Unity Health Toronto, where she primarily offers ethics support to Baycrest Hospital & LTC, Toronto Grace Health Centre, and Surrey Place. Andria focuses her ethics practice on ethical issues related to rehabilitation, older adults, and persons with cognitive impairment. Her doctoral work focused on the ethics of sexual consent and older adults with dementia. In addition to her career in clinical ethics, Andria is an Assistant Professor (status-only) at the Dalla Lana School of Public Health - University of Toronto and an Affiliate Scientist at KITE Research Institute. Andria also serves as Chair of the Stakeholder Advisory Council of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority and is on the Board of Directors of the Canadian Association of Practicing Healthcare Ethicists - Association Canadienne des Éthiciens en Soins de Santé.
