Antipsychotic Taper Project Success Story

## **PRESENTERS:**

Alana lozzo RPN, I am a registered practical nurse working for Mackenzie Health BSO mobile team. Previously working as a BSO Lead in an LTC in Toronto for 1.5 years, where I successfully brought the antipsychotic quality indicator down from 34% to 8% and helped taper many residents off of antipsychotic medications, while using non-pharmacological strategies and interventions to manage responsive behaviours.
